Publication Requirements

Scientific paper up to 6 pages, A4 Font 14 (Times New Roman), single line space. Symmetrical margins 20 мм.

General requirements:

- 1. Title of the paper capitalized in bold type (center alignment).
- 2. Space line. Then family name and first name of the author.
- 3. Academic degree, place of work, position, city, country (flush right alignment).
- 4. Abstract in italics.
- 6. Key words in italics.
- 7. Space line. The main body of the article, width alignment. Paragraph indention 1.25.
- 8. Space line. The word references must be capitalized and in bold type. Literary references within the article are presented in square brackets [1]. Books and articles, etc., in the list of references are provided in the order of their appearance in the text.
