PROFESSIONAL BIOGRAPHY & SHORT SUMMARY OF RESEARCH INTERESTS

- Dr. Daria Smirnova currently acts as a Director of the International Centre for Education and Research in Neuropsychiatry and an Associate Professor of the Department of Psychiatry, Samara State Medical University (Russia). Dr. Smirnova has been a lecturer for undergraduate and postgraduate students in the field of psychiatry since 2006. Her career background includes basic training in General Medicine (MD) with postgraduate course in Psychiatry (Samara State Medical University) and research experience (PhD, Medical Sciences, Psychiatry, Moscow Research Institute of Psychiatry). Dr. Smirnova also works as a consultant in psychiatry and psychotherapy.
- Main research interests and experience in psychiatry of Dr. Smirnova focus on Affective disorders and Schizophrenia, in particular, the psycholinguistic approach related to mental disorders. Scientific background includes a PhD program on early recognition of depression using linguistic diagnostic markers in Russian-speaking patients. In 2012 Dr. Smirnova participated in the international collaborative project on language dysfunction and compensatory resources of second language acquisition in a population of Russian-Hebrew bilinguals with schizophrenia in Israel (Professors Haim Belmaker, Yuli Bersudsky, Joel Walters, Jonathan Fine, Ben-Gurion University of Negev, Bar-Ilan University, Israel). In 2014 she was awarded GoEight European fellowship to continue her research on thought, language and communication dysfunction in English-speaking patients using the dataset of Western Australian Family Study Schizophrenia (Professors Assen Jablensky, Johanna Badcock, Centre for Clinical Research in Neuropsychiatry, University of Western Australia, Australia) and acted as a Visiting Research fellow by contract since 20145 till 2020. In the period 2015-2017 Dr. Smirnova coordinated the multi-centre collaborative project on validation of Russian version of the Diagnostic Interview for Psychoses in 7 Russian sites. Since 2016 Dr. Smirnova coordinates a multicentre study on action-related language impairments in Schizophrenia patients and relatives and patients' insight related to the decline in language structure, pragmatics and social engagement using Communication Checklist Self-Report (first use in Schizophrenia). Dr. Smirnova is also working on multicentre collaborative projects on Schizophrenia staging using PANSS (Professor Konstantinos Fountoulakis, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece; Linköping University, Linköping, Sweden), since 2020 - as a project coordinator for the project on "Estimating COVID-19 outbreak on mental health in general population and students across 40 countries", "COVID-19 associated neuropsychiatric complications", "The WPA-CINP study on Tool development for Psychosis (WPA-CINP TOP study, 30 countries)" and published 100+ papers, including 31 WoS, 24 Scopus peer-review articles, as well as several textbook chapters, including "Schizophrenia and Bilingualism", "Evidence-based outcome for the interventions in early-onset schizophrenia", "Language impairments in dementia" and others for the international academic editions.
- Dr. Smirnova is a member of Editorial Boards of the Asian Journal of Psychiatry (Q2, Elsevier), Frontiers in Psychiatry (Q1, Psychosomatic Medicine, Public Helath), Indian Journal of Mental Health, Middle East Current Psychiatry Journal (Q4, Springer) and acts as a reviewer for several peer-review journals, such as Current Psychology; The Journal of General Psychology; Frontiers in Psychiatry; Psychiatry Research; Brain and Language; Language, Cognition and Neuroscience, and others.
- Dr. Smirnova acts as a member of several professional organisations, including Russian Society of Psychiatry (Section on International Collaboration Member), World Psychiatric Association (Evidence based Psychiatry Section Member), European Depression Association (National Representative of Russia), Argentinian Psychiatric Association (Clinical psychiatry Section Board Member), and responsible for organisation of the European Depression Day in Russia and moderates the series of the international webinars on evidenced-based psychopharmacology, meet the expert sessions and COVID-19 associated neuropsychiatric disturbances organised by MSc Clinical Mental Health, AuTh (Prof. K.
