ПРОФЕССИОНАЛЬНАЯ БИОГРАФИЯ И ОПЫТ НАУЧНОЙ ДЕЯТЕЛЬНОСТИ

- Дарья Александровна Смирнова (22.08.1981 г.р.) в настоящее время является директором Международного Научно-образовательного центра нейропсихиатрии и доцентом кафедры психиатрии, наркологии, психотерапии и клинической психологии Самарского государственного медицинского университета.
- Д.А. Смирнова закончила медицинский лицей-колледж с золотой медалью (1998 год), лечебный факультет СамГМУ с красным дипломом (1998-2004 г.), обучалась в клинической ординатуре (2004 – 2006 гг.) и очной аспирантуре по специальности «Психиатрия» (2006 – 2010 гг.), защитила кандидатскую диссертацию по специальности по теме «Клинические и лингвистические характеристики легких депрессий» в Московском НИИ психиатрии (2010 г.). Д-р Смирнова является врачом-психиатром высшей квалификационной категории, имеет дипломы по переподготовке по психотерапии, семейной системной психотерапии, наркологии, и консультирует пациентов различных диагностических категорий, ведет психотерапевтический прием, преподает курсы по направлениям психиатрии и психотерапии обучающимся додипломного и последипломного блока обучения СамГМУ, курирует научную работу студентов, в частности, образовательного института обучения иностранных граждан.
- **Основные научные интересы и опыт научной деятельности** Д.А. Смирновой сфокусированы на вопросах изучения аффективных расстройств и шизофрении, в частности, разработки и внедрения психолингвистического подхода в психиатрии. С 2006 по 2010 гг. реализован проект по раннему распознаванию депрессии с включением лингвистических диагностических маркеров у русскоязычных пациентов. В 2012 году Д.А. Смирнова принимала участие в международном проекте по изучению нарушений речи у мигрантов-билингвов с шизофренией и компенсаторным ресурсам билингвализма при психических расстройствах в Университетах Бен Гурион и Бар-Илан, Центре психического здоровья Бершевы в Израиле (Основные исследователи: психиатрия - профессора Х. Белмайкер, Ю. Берсудский, лингвистика – профессора Дж. Уолтерс, Дж. Файн, Бен-Гурион). В 2014 Д.А. Смирнова получила престижную стипендию для европейских кандидатов от австралийской организации GoEight (восьмерка ведущих университетов Австралии) для продолжения исследований по расстройствам мышления, языка и коммуникации при шизофрении и являлась приглашенным научным сотрудником по контракту в рабочей группе Центра клинических исследований в нейропсихиатрии Университета Западной Австралии в г. Перт (Основные исследователи: профессора А. Жабленски, Дж. Бэдлок, 2014 – 2019 гг.). В период 2015 - 2017 гг. Д.А. Смирнова координировала многоцентровый проект по валидации русскоязычной версии Диагностического интервью для психозов. С 2016 г. координирует многоцентровое исследование нарушений языка, мышления и коммуникаций у пациентов с шизофренией и их родственников. Доктор Смирнова принимала участие в ряде международных коллaborативных проектов, посвященных стигматизации психических расстройств и организации психиатрической помощи в Европе (профессора Н. Сарториус, Х. Стюарт. Г. Торникрофт), стадийности шизофрении (профессора К. Фунтулакис) и др. С 2020 года выступает в качестве главного координатора международного научного проекта на тему оценки психического здоровья населения во время локдауна пандемии COVID-19 в 40 странах.
- В 2019 году Д. Смирнова получила **премию Европейской психиатрической ассоциации** за лучшую статью, опубликованную по теме диагностики психических расстройств и клинической психопатологии в европейском рецензируемом журнале в 2018 году.
- Д.А. Смирнова является **автором и соавтором** более 100 статей, в том числе, более 30 статей, индексируемых в научных системах Scopus и Web-of-Science, а также нескольких глав в зарубежных учебниках и коллективных монографиях, в том числе «Шизофрения и Билингвализм», «Доказательная терапия шизофрении с началом в раннем детском возрасте», «Нарушения речи при деменции» и др.

- Д.А. - Доктор Смирнова была избрана и выполняла **должностные обязанности** в роли председателя Самарского отделения Совета молодых ученых Российского общества психиатров (мандатный период 2009-2011 гг.), а затем общероссийского отделения (2011-2013 гг.), Азиатской Федерации начинающих карьеру психиатров (2011-2013 гг.), в настоящее время является представителем нескольких профессиональных организаций, включая Российское общество психиатрии (Секция международного сотрудничества), Всемирную психиатрическую ассоциацию (Секция доказательной психиатрии), Европейскую ассоциацию по борьбе с депрессией (Национальный представитель России), Аргентинскую психиатрическую ассоциацию (Член правления Секции клинической психиатрии), отвечает за организацию Европейского дня по борьбе с депрессией в России и модерирует серию международных вебинаров по доказательной психофармакологии, экспертных сессий и онлайн-конференций по теме психических нарушений при COVID-19, организованных в рамках программы MSc Clinical Mental Health Университета Аристотеля в Салониках в сотрудничестве со Всемирной психиатрической ассоциацией, Всемирной Организацией здравоохранения (Проф. К. Фунтулакис).
- **Международный научно-образовательный центр нейропсихиатрии** (International Centre for Education and Research in Neuropsychiatry, ICERN), который возглавила Д.А. Смирнова, создан в СамГМУ в 2021 году по инициативе ректора, профессора РАН, д.м.н. А.В. Колсанова, в рамках развития приоритетного направления исследований в области фундаментальных и клинических нейронаук. Решение объединить в команду российских и зарубежных ученых (первая и уникальная в своем роде форма международной научно-образовательной коллaborации в области нейропсихиатрии в РФ), работающих в очном и дистанционном формате - нейробиологов, нейрогенетиков, неврологов, психиатров, психологов, психофармакологов и профессионалов других прикладных наук о мозге, является важным шагом руководства, ориентированного на прогрессивные модели организации научного и образовательного пространства в современном университете и для современного специалиста. Главным советником в штате сотрудников центра является профессор П.В. Морозов (РНИМУ им. Пирогова, г. Москва), генеральный секретарь Всемирной психиатрической ассоциации. Соруководителем центра и главным исследователем является профессор К. Фунтулакис (Университет Аристотеля в Салониках, Греция), член правления, руководитель 8 зоны и Секции доказательной психиатрии Всемирной психиатрической ассоциации, представитель Всемирной организации здравоохранения и глава Кохрейн библиотеки в Греции.
